Trails

Lake Walk

This circular walk of approximately five miles starts from the Gilfach Ddu car park. For most of the way it follows well made paths and quiet country roads. It is a moderately easy walk with many outstanding views along the way.

Vivian Trail

This magnificent walk combines industrial archaeology with wilderness experiences, taking in the heritage of the quarrying industry and its harshness, whilst giving unparalleled views of the surrounding mountains and lakes.

Woodland Walk

Following the last period of glaciation, north Wales was colonised with natural woodland. Most of the more fertile valleys and hillsides were cleared by man to allow for farming needs. The remaining oak woodlands are those in areas difficult to cultivate. Coed Dinorwig is a fragment of one of these early forests.

Nature Trail

The Nature Trail allows you to explore and discover the magic of Coed Dinorwig.

Kingfisher Trail

Access for the less able - the trail leads from the Gilfach Ddu car park and is designed for less able users and wheelchairs. Visit the lake shore or go to watch climbers and divers in the Vivian Quarry or visit the only working slate incline in the area.

Like to do something different?

How about:

- Walking a number of themed trails to be explored - always follow the waymarks follow the waymarks. See map.
- Bird watching many people visit Padarn just to catch a glimpse of the variety of different species of bird that we have here. Birds like the Woodpecker can be seen, with Buzzards, Choughs, as well as old friends like the Robin!
- On the lake see magnificent Swans, Cormorants, Dabchicks and lots and lots of Ducks!
- Photographers and Artists are in their element here. Dramatic changes in colours from one season to the next, lends itself superbly to photography and painting.
- Climbing and Abseiling in the Park was first undertaken by the Quarrymen. Those who want to try their hand at the easier standard should seek out the services of professional climbing instructors.
- Sub Aqua Diving is becoming more and more popular, with divers travelling from all over the UK to dive in the Vivian Quarry Pool.
- Kayaking, rowing and paddle boarding are very popular on the lake. Follow the respective guidelines/regulations for your craft or activity. Be aware of open water swimmers in the lake.
- Most of the Park is unsuitable for Cycling but the Lôn Las Peris cycle track runs along the western shore of the lake - see map.
- Picnic sites are situated close to the car parks, but you can have a picnic just about anywhere out of the way - you decide!
